The quote from Innovation Solutions was moved to the consent agenda for approval. The board expressed an interest in having a 201 Sewer tour of an overview of the areas. This will be schedule in the spring of 2022.

Brian Lawrence has drafted a new Road Policy, with the guidance from the board. Brian will continue to work on the Road Policy adding all necessary ordinances and a Road Maintenance section to have it all under one policy. Update on Road Maintenance, no discussion. Road counts were discussed, and the counting machines are kept on the gravel roads for 1 week. The quotes were reviewed from Muellers and Bryan Rock, class 5 gravel is \$3.00 a yard higher than last year. Road tour date to come.

There were no projects on the CCWDM Share project that the Township qualifies for.

Public Works will be hiring a summer intern, starting wage will be \$16.00 hr, and working 24 hours a week. All candidates must be 18 years old.

Nuss Trucking Equipment gave a quote for a new truck of \$36,500.00 and a trade in for the 1997 Ford Snowplow truck for \$5,000.00. Brian and James thought that was low for the trade in and will negotiate for more money.
