Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Melissa Lano stated that the Board is not allowed to present a separate fund in the financial statements for just a savings type account of "excess". By definition, a fund needs to have a funding stream to be able to be reported separately in the financial statements. Therefore, all the tax levy money for roads must be put into this fund as well if a separate Road and Bridge fund were to be created. This would include tax settlements related to the Road and Bridge Levy, as well as Town Road allotment, etc. The tax levy funding revenue stream would meet the requirements of a new fund. Any excess Road and Bridge levy money collected is restricted in the general fund. The recommendation is to create a spreadsheet to track excess General Fund Road and Bridge monies carried over from year to year to be used for future road projects.

Motion to amend the Treasurer's Report for the Sewer Services disbursement of \$1,666.00 to be dispersed from the ARPA fund.

Also, sign the letter of support for Carver County's application for the Highway 10 Mobility and Access Corridor Improvement under the Roadway Strategic Capacity category of the Metropolitan Council's 2022 Regional Solicitation for federal transportation funding.

Victoria Sports Complex

In the interest of transparency and public awareness, the Board discussed hosting a Township public meeting to discuss the proposed Victoria Sports Complex. The Board has fielded many calls from residents expressing concern and requesting information, for which the Board is unable to answer due to lack of involvement in the proposed project. Chair Parris will invite City of Victoria key staff and the Mayor. Invitations will also be extended to Commissioner Fahey, key local legislators and interested/affected residents. More information will be forthcoming regarding date/time if an agreement to meet is established. The Representative and Senator returned the Bill to the Author.

Other

Crown College is refinancing a debt and securing a new bond for an addition. They have requested that the Township consider giving host approval and consent issuance by the City of Mayer and the City of St Boni for revenue obligations. This is a tax-exempt bond, there is no debt liability for the Township, purely a paper transaction. Mike Couri recommended the bond be reviewed by bond council Kennedy Graven. Attorney fees will be paid by Crown College.
